**Directions from I-35: (from the south)**  
 Exit onto Hwy. 30 West. Follow to the Ogden exit and take P70 North (right). Head north just over 14 miles and start looking for green road signs that say "Hidden Acres Christian Center." Follow the arrows.

**Directions from I-35: (from the north)**  
 Exit onto Hwy. 175 West. Follow about 30 miles, cross river, then take P70 south (left). Look for the green road signs that say "Hidden Acres Christian Center." Follow the arrows.

## Retreat Speakers



**Dr. Tom Nelson** - Prayer can be a real mystery. At times it is a huge struggle and then, at other times, it is a source of joy and life. We are not alone in our struggle with prayer. Jesus' disciples also wrestled with prayer and they wanted in on what Jesus had. Tom will present three messages at this Retreat on the subject, "Teach Us to Pray."

He will also present a final message on Tuesday afternoon that will help us assist our church people to live out a theology of work in the everyday ebb and flow of life.

Tom graduated with a Masters of Theology degree from Dallas Theological Seminary and received his doctorate from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. He and his wife, Liz, arrived in Kansas City in 1988 to begin Christ Community Church. Tom has served as Senior Pastor there since that time and received his ordination with the EFCA in 1992. Tom has authored the books, "Five Smooth Stones" and "Ekklesia". His newest book, "Work Matters" is due to be released October 2011.

**Jordon and Barbara Korell** - God used Valley Church and the National Institute of Marriage (Gary Smalley) to restore Jordon and Barbara to deep marriage intimacy from the pain of an affair, betrayal and deception. The Korell's have been sharing God's miracle in their lives and are passionate to help couples experience God's healing. On Tuesday, they will share God's Word as it applies to all marriage relationships and share what they are learning on how to travel the path towards true oneness in marriage.

Jordon and Barbara have ministered full time internationally in India with The Evangelical Alliance Mission (TEAM), and state-side as a Pastor in the Evangelical Free Church. Jordon has an MDiv from Trinity Evangelical Seminary.
