



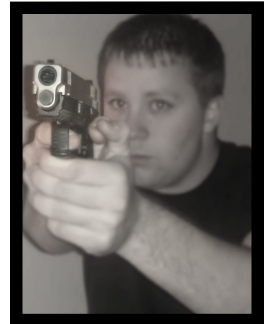

Weekend Training Options

R P Precision Shooting - Permit to Carry Concealed Firearms Class:

This class will be taught by NRA certified instructor Robbie Pepper. Robbie is a member of the Dayton Police department as well as an employee of Sportsmen's Warehouse in Ankeny. He has been teaching certification classes for the last year. This class will cover the training required by Iowa Law to obtain a permit to carry concealed firearms. Bird Dog Training: Alan Hill is a long time Iowa bird hunter and a resident of Garden City, Iowa. Alan has had a lot of experience in training dogs. He has bred and trained greyhounds as well as good hunting dogs. This class will teach you the basics of how to begin to train your dog to be a quality tool in the field. Using hand signals and basic commands to get your dog where you want it to go. Alan will give you instruction and pointers to create a great experience with you and your dog in the hunting season.
