



The Residency at Hidden Acres is a one-year integrated master's degree program designed to **educate, equip,** and **empower** the next generation of servant leaders for a lifetime of Christian ministry.

## FINANCIAL DETAILS

A primary goal of The Residency's academic option is to launch residents who are not only equipped for ministry but are also financially secure. While an average Christian college master's degree distance learning program can cost well over \$13,000 and take two years to complete, this one-year program can cover much of the cost of the degree program and could also allow students to earn a net income of up to \$2,100, depending on which college track is chosen.

**Income:** Residents receive a \$9,600 (\$800/mo, 12 months) work stipend from Hidden Acres and a \$5,000 ministry scholarship (\$500/mo, 10 months) from the ministry in which they are placed. That's \$14,600 of income for the year.

**Expenses:** The program cost is \$5,000 for the year. This covers housing, food, professional development trips, and Hidden Acres gear. Residents also pay tuition to one of the two universities (\$7,500 for Anchor or \$12,850 for Southwest Baptist).

**Net Income:** Residents earn enough in one year from the stipend and scholarship to cover the cost of the program fee and tuition from Anchor Christian or a large portion of the tuition for Southwest Baptist.

**Housing:** Residents live in either the Pavilion or the Danielson House at Hidden Acres with other residents and the students of Project Path, our gap year program. During the summer, residents may move to different housing at Hidden Acres, depending on their position on our summer staff.

**Food:** Residents have access to food at the Hidden Acres dining hall whenever meals are served. This will include a staff lunch every day during the week and typically 3-6 meals on the weekend, depending on the groups that are at camp. Residents may also have access to leftovers from the dining hall when available.
