Hidden Acres Christian Center is a camp and conference center purchased in 1979 by the Central District Evangelical Free Churches. Our mission is to be "a place set apart to encounter Jesus."

We are located on 660 forested acres near Dayton, lowa, in the beautiful Des Moines River Valley. Today we have more than 60 buildings, housing for over 800, and a dining hall that seats 1,000. Hidden Acres offers many enjoyable activities, including an indoor pool & hot tub, gym, game room, lake, pond, blob, sledding hill, climbing wall, zip line, giant swing, horse rides, and hiking paths. We typically host over 20,000 guests each year. Last summer, we had over 3,800 summer campers and 180 summer staff.

CAMP & COLLEGE PARTNERSHIP



STUDENT FINANCES

INCOME DETAILS

WORK STIPEND: \$1,000/MONTH

Students will receive a monthly stipend for their work at camp. Over a semester, that will equal approximately \$4,000.



EXPENSE DETAILS

PROGRAM COST: \$2,500/SEMESTER Includes housing, food, trips, and camp clothing

EMMAUS TUITION: \$200/CREDIT

One 3-credit course required per semester, equaling a minimum of \$600 tuition per semester.



Total of program cost and tuition for one course. Due in full on October 1 and February 1. Students may take up to two additional courses, for a maximum semester cost of \$4,300 for nine credits.
