

Camper Code of Conduct

For the mutual safety and growth of all our guests, campers will be held to this standard of conduct. A refusal to comply with these codes of conduct may result in dismissal from the summer camp program without a refund, and the parents are responsible for transportation.

Prohibited Items

These items will be removed and kept in the office if they are found:

- Food/Snacks
- Phones/Electronics
- Cigarettes/Drugs/Alcohol/Vapes
- Knives/Weapons/Firearms
- Fireworks/Sparklers
- Pets/Animals

Behavior

- Campers must follow the instructions of Hidden Acres staff members and be supervised at all times.
- Campers may not leave camp unless accompanied by a parent/guardian or a staff member.
- Campers may not enter any cabin of the opposite gender.
- Campers may not steal or vandalize the property of campers, counselors, or the camp.
- Campers may not undermine the safety (physical, mental, emotional, etc.) of any camper or staff member, whether through violence, bullying, threatening, or any other means.

Dress Code

Hidden Acres has the following dress code, and counselors may ask a camper to change clothes if an outfit does not align with this code:

- Shirt straps at least two fingers wide
- Shorts that come to at least mid-thigh when standing
- No underwear, cleavage, buttocks, or stomach showing
- No writing on the backside of shorts or pants
- No form fitting clothing (such as leggings, yoga pants, or compression shirts)
- Swimsuits
 - Girls: swimsuit that fully covers the stomach
 - Boys: summing trunks (no speedos)
- Close-toe shoes must be worn on the climbing tower, zipline, giant swing, hikes, and horse rides.
