### **Traditional Camp Rules**

- You must wear your wristbands. They tell us that you're registered.
- Quiet hours are 11:00p-7:00a. Be courteous in the evenings as many families have young kids with early bedtimes. Please do not leave children unattended.
- Dogs must be on leashes or tied up, and please pick up after them. No animals are allowed in any buildings or cabins, even if they're carried or are in kennels.
- No alcohol is permitted on the grounds at Hidden Acres. Smoking is allowed outdoors, but please extinguish and dispose of used cigarettes properly.
- Please keep all vehicles, including ATVs, on gravel roadways and off hiking trails. Vehicle operators must be <u>at least 16 years old</u> & have a driver's license. If your vehicle is too loud, going too fast, or operated by someone too young, our staff will ask you to stop using that vehicle for the weekend.
- Swimsuits must be modest; one-piece swim suits or cover-ups should be worn and should only be visible at the pool and lake, not areas like sand volleyball.
- Please do not leave items in the Family Life Center (FLC) locker rooms. Items are collected daily at 11:00p and taken to the office.

  - \* Horse Trail Rides— ~45 minutes; \$25/person; ages 10+. Weight limit: 225lb. Wear long pants and close-toed shoes. Meet at the Barn.
  - \* <u>Brunch Trail Ride or Brunch Wagon Ride</u>—Same destination & meal; meet at the Barn. **Trail Ride:** \$30/person. Same restrictions as trail rides. **Wagon Ride:** \$10/person, no restrictions. Price is \$5 lower for those with brunch meal plan.
  - \* <u>Lead-Me Horse Rides</u>—5-10 minute arena rides. \$5/ride; for ages 9 & under. Sign up for a time slot at the office. Rides held at the Outdoor Arena.
  - \* Adventure Activity Tickets—\$5 per ride; can be used for the Climbing Wall, Zip Line, or Giant Swing. Riders must fit in a harness (smallest size fits <u>5 year old</u>). Climbing Wall weight limit is 50-300 lbs. Zip Line weight limit is 50-225 lbs. Giant Swing has no limit. You can also pay at the event.
  - \* <u>Tower Wristbands</u>—\$30 per person; these wristbands allow the wearer unlimited climbing, zipping, and swinging all weekend.
  - \* <u>Cookie Makes</u>—\$10 per family. Make chocolate chip or monster (peanuts) dough as a family. We'll freeze it for you to take home. At the Dining Hall.
  - \* <u>Peach Pack Wagon Rides</u>—\$5/person; meet at the Welcome Center for a wagon shuttle & peach pack campfire dessert.
  - \* <u>Campfire Monkey Bread with Kaleb</u>—\$5/person; meet at the Welcome Center for a wagon shuttle and monkey bread baked over the fire!
  - \* <u>Border Wagon Tour</u>—\$5/person; meet at the Barn for a bumpy, slightly offroad wagon tour visiting neat areas along the border of camp's property.

### Session 1: Families of Faith (Sat. AM)

- 1. List the "blessings" believers in Christ receive according to Ephesians 1:4-14.
- 2. Which of these blessings are an encouragement to you right now?
- 3. Do you ever feel like you aren't good enough or don't have what it takes in life?
- 4. How might the truths of these Bible verses help you when you feel like you haven't got what it takes?
- 5. Have you personally placed your faith in Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord?

### Session 2: Families of Prayer (Sat. PM)

- 1. How are you like your father?
- 2. In what ways would you like to be more like your Heavenly Father?
- 3. Share about a home repair or renovation project that you've experienced. How is that a helpful picture of what the Holy Spirit wants to do in you?
- 4. What are of your life do you need power to be more like Jesus? Pray for that for each other.
- 5. Have you personally embraced your Heavenly Father's purpose to know Christ and grow in Him?

### Session 3: Families of Love (Sun. AM)

- 1. Name one way that God might be calling you to better live as someone who knows him personally.
- 2. What do you find harder: "putting off the old" (Ephesians 4:22) or "putting on the new" (Ephesians 4:24)?
- 3. Evaluate your walk and talk based on Ephesians 4:25-32. What do you need to "put off?" What do you need to "put on?"
- 4. List the different roles in life from Ephesians 5:15-6:9.
- 5. What is one way God might be calling you to more faithfully love others in your role(s) in life?

### Session 4: Families on Mission (Sun. PM)

- 1. What do you know about the spiritual forces of evil (Ephesians 6:12)?
- 2. Which spiritual tactic is most effective against you: deception, division, distraction, or destruction?
- 3. Re-read Ephesians 6:13-17. What piece of armor is a challenge for you to put on? Which piece of armor are you most familiar with putting on?
- 4. How can you better employ the weapon of God's Word (Ephesians 6:17)?
- 5. This passage concludes with prayer (Ephesians 6:18-20). Take turns praying for each other. Pray specifically for one way you would like God to work in your life, your family, your church, and your community.

### **Free Time Suggestions**

- Animal Farm: Visit our cute farm animals at the Barn this weekend! We have goats, sheep, pigs, and mini horses!
- BB Guns, Archery, & Disc Golf: \*NEW Rules\* Adults may rent from the Welcome Center a bow, a bb gun, or a set of disc golf discs for \$2/hour. Please only rent one item per family member and return them after one hour. The disc golf course and bb/archery range are located near the Hall. Fees non-refundable.
- Ben's Trail: Hike our intermediate trail, which begins north of Lechler Lake and ends at the Prayer Tree Cross. Also check out the Prayer Tree Maze!
- Challenge Course: Try this fun team building exercise! Challenges are located in the wooded area of the Prayer Tree Maze (north of Johnson Lodge). The course is difficult, but work as a team and think outside the box!
- Family Life Center (FLC): Snack Shop and Gift Shop are open afternoons and evenings. <u>Building is open 7:00a to midnight each day.</u> The FLC features an open gym, game room, cable TV, swimming pool, and hot tub. Any children swimming <u>MUST</u> be supervised by a parent as no lifeguard is on duty.
- Game Field: Located near camp entrance. A box by the volleyball court has balls & Frisbees. Organize a game of soccer or volleyball (no swim suits, please).
- Horse Shoes: Pits are located near the FLC playground equipment.
- **Human Foosball:** The human foosball structure is located at The Hangout. Grab some friends, split into two teams, and play!
- Lechler Lake & Jesse's Pond: Boats may be used for free during daylight hours.
   Children MUST be accompanied by an adult as there are no lifeguards on duty.
   Life jackets MUST be worn by children and anyone using the blob. The waterslide at the lake is open Saturday & Sunday from 2:00-4:00p and has a weight limit of 250 lbs.
