Specialist Job Descriptions

Airsoft Specialist - This specialist will work alongside the program team to lead our airsoft program. This includes preparing for airsoft matches, caring for and repairing equipment, creating games, and enforcing safety procedures.

Creation Education Specialist - This specialist will teach about and care for animals within the creation center. They will teach campers about nature and God's perfect design through interactive lessons at the creation center.

Craft Specialist - This specialist will create and conduct age-appropriate crafts for campers. They are responsible for stocking craft supplies and scheduling craft times.

Video Specialist - This specialist will work with the media team to record, create, and edit highlight videos, promos, and other videography needs during summer camp.

Photography Specialist - This specialist will work with the media team to shoot and upload weekly cabin photos, take photos of daily activities, and upload photos to social media sites.

Social Media Specialist - This specialist is responsible for posting pictures and videos to the camp's various social media accounts and overseeing engagement with our followers.

Shooting/Archery Specialist - This specialist will work alongside the program team to lead our shooting program. This includes preparing for archery and shooting times, teaching marksmanship, and enforcing safety procedures. The shooting specialist will also assist with shooting camps.

Wilderness/Fishing Outfitter - The wilderness/fishing outfitter will work alongside the program team to assist our wilderness and fishing programs. This includes assembling supplies and equipment, helping maintain equipment, and supporting those leading wilderness/fishing programming.

Tower Specialist - (No experience necessary) This specialist will work alongside the program team to run our high adventure activities. They will help prepare and run all aspects of the tower, enforce safety procedures, and assist cabins as they do activities at the tower.

Waterfront Specialist - (Lifeguard Certification Required) This specialist will work alongside the program team to schedule lifequards at the pool and lake and run all waterfront activities. They are also responsible for the care and maintenance of all equipment used at the lake and pool.

Activity Specialist - This specialist will work alongside the program team to set up and teardown large camp games. They are responsible for the proper storage of program equipment and will assist the team in other program areas.

Office Specialist - This specialist will work with the office team by assisting with check-in procedures, answering phones, answering emails, assisting guests, etc.

Snack Shop Specialist - This specialist will lead a crew of staff members in running the snack shop. They are responsible for restocking the shop and making sure it is ready for campers each afternoon.

Special Needs Coordinator - The special needs coordinator is responsible for managing the needs of campers with special needs. They will contact parents and support counselors who have campers with special needs .

Chapel Coordinator - The chapel coordinator is responsible for leading the worship team, sound needs, speaker needs, slides, and other chapel needs.

Assistant Chapel Coordinator - The assistant chapel coordinator will assist the chapel coordinator with the worship team, sound needs, speaker needs, slides, and other chapel needs.
